

Recap of County Commissioners Meeting April 25, 2006.

1. 9:15 a.m. – Volunteer Recognition – Chris Galvin.
2. It was moved by Mr. Koebel and seconded by Mr. Papcun that the minutes of the previous meeting are approved. Carl and John voted yes.
3. It was moved by Mr. Papcun and seconded by Mr. Koebel that the requests for expenses be approved. Carl and John voted yes.
4. It was moved by Mr. Papcun and seconded by Mr. Koebel that the Board of Ottawa County Commissioners set a bid opening date of Thursday, May 18, 2006 at 10:00 a.m., E.D.T., at which time bids received will be opened for Supplying Pipe for the County Engineer.
