

Recap of County Commissioners Meeting July 20, 2006.

1. It was moved by Mr. Papcun and seconded by Mr. Koebel that the minutes of the previous meeting are approved. All voted yes.
2. It was moved by Mr. Papcun and seconded by Mr. Koebel that the following requests for expenses be approved. All voted yes.
3. It was moved by Mr. Koebel and seconded by Mr. Papcun that the Ottawa County Voucher Report dated July 17 & July 18, 2006 in the total amount of \$992,158.21 be approved for payment and that the County Auditor be authorized to issue the warrant on the County Treasury for payment of same. The voucher reports are available for review in the office of the Ottawa County Commissioners. All voted yes.
4. It was moved by Mr. Koebel and seconded by Mr. Papcun that the Board of Ottawa County Commissioners hereby accept Old Stone Trail as a public road and be designated as T.R. #1223. The roadway has been satisfactorily maintained in accordance with the Ottawa County Subdivision Regulations and in agreement with the Allen Township Trustees who will accept future maintenance of the road. This action is taken upon the recommendation of the County Engineer. Motion was withdrawn from table for further discussion.
