

Recap of County Commissioners Meeting January 23, 2007.  
Carl Koebel, present; Jim Sass, present; Steve Arndt, present.

1. It was moved by Mr. Sass and seconded by Mr. Arndt that the minutes of the previous meeting are approved. All voted yes.
2. It was moved by Mr. Sass and seconded by Mr. Arndt that the Board of Ottawa County Commissioners approve a reduction of up to 50% of the maximum legal vehicle load limit on county roads effective February 1, 2007 and further authorize the County Engineer to place signs indicating load limits as necessary. Said reduction shall remain in force for and during the period of freezing and thawing. Anyone needing a permit for hauling on the roads that have the reduced load limit may contact the County Engineer. There is no charge for that permit. This action is taken upon the request of the County Engineer. All voted yes.
3. It was moved by Mr. Koebel and seconded by Mr. Sass that the requests for expenses be approved. All voted yes.
4. It was moved by Mr. Arndt and seconded by Mr. Sass that the Board of Ottawa County Commissioners hereby authorize the transfers and appropriations as requested by RVNH, Sanitary Engineer, Clerk of Courts and Juvenile Court and as recommended by the County Administrator. All voted yes.
