

Recap of County Commissioners Meeting October 26, 2006.  
Steve Arndt, absent; Carl Koebel, present; John Papcun, present.

1. It was moved by Mr. Papcun and seconded by Mr. Koebel that the minutes of the previous meeting are approved. Carl and John voted yes.
2. It was moved by Mr. Papcun and seconded by Mr. Koebel that the requests for expenses be approved. Carl and John voted yes.
3. It was moved by Mr. Papcun and seconded by Mr. Koebel that the Board of Ottawa County Commissioners request the County Auditor to establish a fund for MRDD and the Riverview Nursing Home titled "MRDD/RVNH BONDS." This action is taken upon the request of the Clerk/Assistant Administrator. Carl and John voted yes.

It was moved by Mr. Papcun and seconded by Mr. Koebel that the Board of Ottawa County Commissioners request the County Auditor to establish a fund for the County Engineer's Office titled "Port Clinton Eastern Road Construction – Phase II."
