No award will be made as bidding is to establish prices only. The County reserves the right to purchase material from the most economical source. Location of material and job site, as well as any other pertinent factors, will be taken into consideration.

Proposals must be submitted on the forms furnished by the County. Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein.

Bids must be sealed and endorsed on the outside of the envelope with the name of the bidder and the item bid upon.

The person or company making the bid shall provide an Affidavit of Contractor of Supplier of Non-Delinquency of Personal Property Taxes, in accordance with O.R.C. Section 5719.042.

The County Commissioners reserves the right to reject any or all bids, and to waive any irregularities in a bid, or to accept that bid which in the judgment of proper officials is to be in the best interest of the County.
