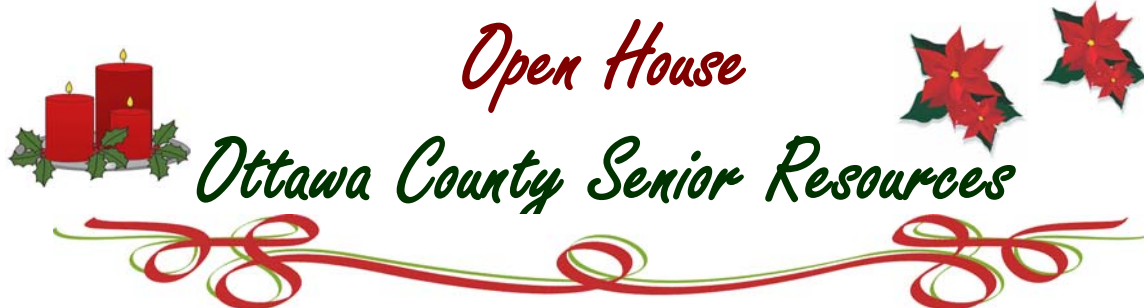

From the Kitchen of Winnie Chasteen EASY PUMPKIN CHEESECAKE

- 1 tub(container) Philadelphia Cream cheese mixture
 - 1 small can solid pumpkin
 - 1 TAB cinnamon
 - 1/2 tsp nutmeg
 - 1/4 tsp ground cloves
- Mix together until well blended and pour into a graham cracker crust. Sprinkle with graham crackers crumbs. Put in refrigerator for 12 hours to firm up.
