## BBB SENIOR ALERT

### Car Warranty Scams Still Targeting Seniors

Seniors continue to receive calls, cards and letters from warranty companies telling them that their auto warranty is about to expire. This is sometimes confusing when the senior knows their warranty won't expire for several months or it has already expired. Many are angered because they are on the Federal Do Not Call List, but these companies don't abide by the law. Some seniors tell us that they receive these calls/mail for warranties and they don't even own a car!

Some warranty companies give the *impression* that they are affiliated with the auto manufacturer or car dealer. Many use high pressure or misleading tactics in selling their product.

One of the big offenders is **Dealer Services, St. Louis, MO**. The

BBB in St. Louis has received almost 700 complaints against the company for various issues. **Dealer Services** promised to change the misleading wording in their mailings but has failed to do so.

Our BBB suggests seniors interested in purchasing an auto warranty:

1) Insist on being able to review the warranty before paying any money. Read it and understand it, including the cancellation clause, before purchasing.

2) Shop around. Compare coverage, deductibles - do you have to use "their" mechanic? Check how repairs are paid - directly to the shop or do you pay upfront then get reimbursed?

3) Talk to your mechanic. Ask him about the companies he likes to deal with and problems he encounters.

4) Then check the warranty company's BBB reliability report. Just calls us at 419-531-3116 or 1-800-743-4222 or check BBB reports at [www.bbb.org](http://www.bbb.org).

#### CHICKEN PAELLA

2 boneless skinless chicken thighs (3 oz ea.)

1/2 cup cubed fully cooked ham

1/3 cup chopped onion

1/3 cup julienne sweet red pepper

1 TAB olive oil, divided

1/2 cup uncooked Arborio rice  
or short grained regular rice

1/2 tsp ground turmeric

1/2 tsp ground cumin

1/2 tsp minced garlic

1/8 tsp salt

1 cup plus 2 tab. chicken  
broth

3/4 frozen peas



#### From the Kitchen of Winnie Chasteen

In a large skillet, sauté the chicken, ham, onion and red pepper in 2 tsp oil until chicken is browned on all sides.

Remove with a slotted spoon.

In the same skillet, sauté rice in remaining oil until lightly browned. Stir in the turmeric, cumin, garlic and salt. Return meat and vegetables to pan; toss lightly. Add broth; bring to a boil. Reduce heat to medium; cover and simmer for 30-35 minutes or until rice is tender.

Stir in peas. Yield 2 servings.
