Guidelines for Ottawa County Senior Hall of Fame Nominations

1. Any senior with involvement in the Senior programs and Senior Nutrition sites of Ottawa County is eligible for nomination to the Senior Hall of Fame.
2. Seniors need to be at least 60 years of age to eligible for nomination.
3. In order to nominate an individual for the Hall of Fame Award, a nomination form must be completed. Forms are available at each Senior Site
4. Nominations forms are due to the Executive Coordinator by **April 12th** to be considered for this year's Hall of Fame Awards.
5. Past recipients of the Hall of Fame award may review nominations and make recommendations to the Nominations Committee.
6. Award winners will be selected by the Nominations Committee, which consists of the Executive Coordinator, the Ottawa County Board of Commissioners and selected individuals from the community involved in Senior programming.
7. Hall of Fame Seniors will receive their award at Senior Day at Camp Perry on Wednesday May 12, 2010.
