

Recap of the County Commissioners Meeting March 4, 2021.

Commissioner Douglas, present; Commissioner Coppeler, present; Commissioner Stahl, present.

10:00 a.m. – Elected Officials and Department Heads Weekly Update. Update from Board of Health on current COVID statistics and vaccine distributions and Riverview Healthcare Campus update.

It was moved by Commissioner Coppeler and seconded by Commissioner Stahl that the minutes of the March 2, 2021 meeting are approved. Vote on Motion: Donald A. Douglas, yes; Mark E. Coppeler, yes; Mark W. Stahl, yes.

It was moved by Commissioner Coppeler and seconded by Commissioner Stahl that the Board of Ottawa County Commissioners authorize the president of the Board to sign the Memorandum of Understanding with the Mental Health & Recovery Board of Erie and Ottawa Counties. This MOU provides funding for wraparound services for Family & Children Services. The MOU shall not exceed \$20,000.00 and is for the period of March 1, 2021 to June 30, 2021 unless terminated earlier. It was moved by Commissioner Coppeler and seconded by Commissioner Stahl that the Ottawa County Voucher Report dated March 2, 2021 in the total amount of \$296,754.70 be approved for payment and that the County Auditor be authorized to issue the warrant on the County Treasury for payment of same.
