

LEGAL NOTICE FOR PUBLIC HEARINGS FOR THE JOINT ELECTRIC
POWER AGGREGATION PLAN OF OPERATING AND GOVERNANCE FOR
OTTAWA COUNTY AND ALL TOWNSHIPS

The Ottawa County Board of Commissioners in conjunction with the following Township Trustees from Danbury, Erie, Harris, Portage, Put-In-Bay, Salem, Allen, Bay, Benton, Carroll, Catawba, and Clay hereby provides notice that it will hold the two required separate public hearings and an additional hearing, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 4928.20 (C), to review and receive comments regarding the "Ottawa County Electric Power Aggregation Plan of Operation and Governance". The hearings will be held on July 13, 2010 at 7:30 p.m. at the Ottawa County Courthouse – 315 Madison Street – Port Clinton and on July 20, 2010 at 5:30 p.m. at the Community Resource Centre – 8043 W. State Route 163 – Oak Harbor and a third hearing on July 29, 2010 at 7:30 p.m. at Schedel Arboretum & Gardens – 19255 W. Portage River South Road – Elmore. The "Ottawa County Electric Power Aggregation Plan of Operation and Governance" describes the policies and procedures by which Ottawa County and joint townships will implement its electric aggregation program, and will include information regarding customer rates and service. The proposed plan provides for the County to act as the lead agency to contract with a retail electric provider. The proposed plan would include all households in the unincorporated areas of the County except those that opt-out. Notification and an educational process are also part of the proposal.
