

## INVITATION TO BID

SEALED BIDS for furnishing of the necessary materials and construction of the

### **PLAT 6 SERVICES WATERLINE AND SANITARY SEWER REPLACEMENT PROJECT OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO**

will be received by Ottawa County, Ohio at the office of the Board of Ottawa County Commissioners, 315 Madison Street, Room 103, Port Clinton, Ohio 43452 until

10:30 a.m. (Local Time)  
Thursday, July 9, 2015

and at that time and place will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Bids must be sealed and endorsed on the outside of the envelope with the name of the bidder and the project bid upon. Bids received after the scheduled bid opening date and time will neither be read nor considered. No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of 60 days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids.

The contract documents, including plans and specifications, are on file at the office of the Ottawa County Sanitary Engineer and the Engineer - BEC Associates, 6622 W Harbor Rd., (SR 163) Port Clinton, Ohio 43452;

The documents may be secured from BEC Associates by contacting them to obtain the download link or by submitting payment to them in the amount of \$25.00 for any established non-refundable fees and applicable postage costs for each set requested.

Potential bidders are required to notify BEC Associates of their desire to be included on the Official Plan Holders List. Bids will only be accepted from contractors listed on the Official Plan Holders Lists. All bids must be signed and submitted on the blanks which are bound in this booklet. Bids must state the unit prices in the blanks provided and be enclosed in a sealed envelope marked --- **PLAT 6 SERVICES WATERLINE AND SANITARY SEWER REPLACEMENT PROJECT** --- and addressed to the Board of Commissioners, Ottawa County, 315 Madison Street, Port Clinton, Ohio 43452.

The owner intends and requires that this project be substantially completed no later than November 30, 2015 and final restoration of the project area by April 15, 2016.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with this project will, to the extent practicable use Ohio Products, materials, services and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Each bid must be accompanied by a bid guaranty. The bid guaranty may be of two forms:

1) A Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond using the form in the Contract Documents. (The amount of the bid does NOT have to appear on this form.)

2) A certified check, cashier's check or letter of credit in favor of Ottawa County, Ohio, in the amount of 10% of the bid. If the contract is awarded a Contract Bond will be required, which is a 100% payment and performance bond. The bid guaranty must meet all requirements of Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Instructions to Bidders.

Pre-Bid Meeting- A pre-bid meeting will be held on Tuesday, July 7, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. in Room 100 of the Ottawa County Courthouse, 315 Madison Street, Port Clinton, Ohio 43452

After the award of the contract let by competitive bid and prior to the time the contract is entered into, bidders shall submit the affidavit required under the Ohio Revised Code, Section 5719.042 that the bidder was not charged with any delinquent personal property taxes in Ottawa County, Ohio.

All work shall be carried out in compliance with all federal, state and local laws, rules and regulations that apply to the work. Any project specification item in conflict with a federal, state, or local law, rule or regulation, shall be void.

The Contractor shall be required to pay not less than the minimum wage rates established by the Department of Industrial Relations of the State of Ohio.

The Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to reject any or all bids, and to waive any irregularities in a bid and to determine the lowest and best bidder. Bidders with Unresolved Findings for Recovery on the State's Auditor's web site will be disqualified.

Domestic steel use requirements as specified in section 153.001 of the revised code apply to this project. Copies of section 153.001 of the revised code can be obtained from any of the offices of the Department of administrative services.

Each bidder shall complete a "Non-Collusion" Affidavit and include it with his proposal. Bids received after the scheduled bid opening date and time, or not accompanied by a satisfactory bid bond or check, will neither be read or considered.

In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 307.87 this shall serve as notification that this notice is available on Ottawa County's internet web site on the world wide web by logging onto [www.co.ottawa.oh.us](http://www.co.ottawa.oh.us) and going to the legal notices/bids link - click on main page and you will be able to view the notice in PDF format.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of 60 days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids.

The estimate for the cost of construction is \$213,100.
