The suggested donation for each meal is \$3.00 per meal. "Suggestion Donation" means that you can pay all, part or none of this cost, whatever you feel you can financially afford. Donations are returned directly back to the Home Delivered Meal program.

The *Ottawa County Senior Home Care* program is available to anyone age 60 years of age or older who is living in a home setting and needs assistance in order to remain safely at home.
