

Recap of the County Commissioners Meeting November 16, 2017.

It was moved by Commissioner Coppeler and seconded by Commissioner Sass that the minutes of the previous meeting are approved. Vote on Motion: Mark W. Stahl, yes; Mark E. Coppeler, yes; James M. Sass, yes.

8:00 a.m. – Budget Hearing – Sheriff. It was moved by Commissioner Sass and seconded by Commissioner Coppeler that the Board of Ottawa County Commissioners enter into executive session at 8:32 a.m. to discuss employment of personnel. Vote on Motion: Mark W. Stahl, yes; Mark E. Coppeler, yes; James M. Sass, yes.

It was moved by Commissioner Sass and seconded by Commissioner Coppeler that the Board of Ottawa County Commissioners return to open session from executive session at 9:02 a.m. Vote on Motion: Mark W. Stahl, yes; Mark E. Coppeler, yes; James M. Sass, yes.

It was moved by Commissioner Coppeler and seconded by Commissioner Sass that the Board of Commissioners authorize the president of the Board to sign an Equipment Lease with Cleveland Communications in the amount of \$2,500 for a period of thirty-six (36) months. The lease is for use of Harris equipment the county has available and is not utilizing. This action is taken upon the recommendation of the Director of the Emergency Management Agency. It was moved by Commissioner Coppeler and seconded by Commissioner Sass that the Board of Commissioners authorize the president of the Board to sign the Consulting and Brokerage Agreement with The Ashley Group to provide consulting assistance for the Ottawa County employee health plan. This agreement is for the period of three (3) years effective January 1, 2018 in the amount of \$32,000 per year. This action is taken upon the recommendation of the County Administrator/Clerk. The contract amount for this project is \$1,144,551.00 and was the lowest of bids received. This action is being taken upon the recommendation of the Sanitary Engineer. Vote on Motion: Mark W. It was moved by Commissioner Coppeler and seconded by Commissioner Sass that the Board of Ottawa County Commissioners award the bid and authorize the president of the Board to sign all notices with North Bay Construction, Inc. for the Portage/Catawba Island Pump Station Improvements. The contract amount for this project is \$786,920.00 and was the lowest of bids received. This action is being taken upon the recommendation of the Sanitary Engineer. Vote on Motion: Mark W. It was moved by Commissioner Coppeler and seconded by Commissioner Sass that the Board of Ottawa County Commissioners re-appoint Mike Schenk as an at-large appointment effective January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018. It was moved by Commissioner Coppeler and seconded by Commissioner Sass that the Board of Commissioners adopt Resolution No. 17-76 consolidating 3 bond issues of the County of Ottawa, Ohio into a consolidated bond issue and establishing the terms of such consolidated issue.
