

INVITATION TO BID

SEALED BIDS for the furnishing of the necessary materials and construction of the

SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENTS, PHASE I, ERIE TOWNSHIP OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO

will be received by Ottawa County, Ohio at the office of the Board of Commissioners, 315 Madison Street, Port Clinton, Ohio 43452 until

11:00 a.m. (Local Time)
Thursday, January 11, 2018

and at that time and place will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The scope of work consists of constructing approximately 4,055 lineal feet of 8" gravity sewer, 61 lineal feet of 4" PVC force main, 20 sanitary manholes, 1 submersible pump station, 2,100 lineal feet of 6" service laterals, 1 grinder pump, and 400 lineal feet of 16" casing bore and jack.

The contract documents, including plans and specifications, are on file at the office of the Ottawa County Sanitary Engineer and the Engineer -- Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc. (PDG). The documents may be viewed and ordered online or obtained from Becker Impressions, 4646 Angola Road, Toledo, Ohio 43615, Telephone 419-385-5303, www.pdgplanroom.com for the cost of printing to be paid to the printing company at the time the documents are picked up. Shipping and tax charges are the bidder's responsibility and payable directly to Becker Impressions.

The Engineer for the project is Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc., 1168 North Main Street, Bowling Green, Ohio 43402.

All bids must be signed and submitted on the blanks which are bound in this booklet. Bids must state the unit prices in the blanks provided and be enclosed in a sealed envelope marked as appropriate for the Contract(s) being included in the bid --- **SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENTS, PHASE I, ERIE TOWNSHIP** --- and be addressed to the Board of Commissioners, Ottawa County, 315 Madison Street, Port Clinton, Ohio 43452.

The bid guaranty may be of two forms:

1. A Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond using the form in the Contract Documents. (The amount of the bid does NOT have to appear on this form.)
2. A certified check, cashier's check or letter of credit in favor of the Ottawa County, Ohio, in the amount of 10% of the bid. If the contract is awarded, a Contract Bond will be required, which is a 100% payment and performance bond.

After the award of the contract let by competitive bid and prior to the time the contract is entered into, bidders shall submit the affidavit required under the Ohio Revised Code,

Section 5719.042 that the bidder was not charged with any delinquent personal property taxes in Ottawa County, Ohio.

This construction of this project will be funded in part with funds made available from the Federal Government through the US Army Corps of Engineers Section 594 program. Bidders must comply with all applicable laws and regulations for construction projects receiving Federal aid including, but not limited to, the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, and the Davis-Bacon Act as amended.

The successful bidder will be required to pay not less than the highest applicable minimum wage rates as established by the federal Davis-Bacon Wage Determinations issued by the U.S. Department of Labor.

Ottawa County, Ohio reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any irregularity in any bid and to determine the lowest and best bidder. Bidders with Unresolved Findings for Recovery on the State Auditor's web site will be disqualified.

DOMESTIC STEEL USE REQUIREMENTS AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 153.001 OF THE REVISED CODE APPLY TO THIS PROJECT. COPIES OF SECTION 153.001 OF THE REVISED CODE CAN BE OBTAINED FROM ANY OF THE OFFICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES.

Each bidder shall complete a "Non-Collusion" Affidavit and include it with his proposal. Bids received after the scheduled bid opening date and time, or not accompanied by a satisfactory bid bond or check, will neither be read or considered.

In accordance with the Ohio Revised Code Section 307.87 this shall serve as notification that this notice is available on Ottawa County's internet web site on the world wide web by logging onto www.co.ottawa.oh.us and going to the legal notices/bids link - click on main page and you will be able to view the notice in PDF format.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of 90 days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids.

This project is being partially funded with monies from Ohio Public Work Commission (OPWC) and United States Corps of Engineers (USCOE).

The opinion of the probable cost of construction is \$1,108,156.
