

PUBLIC HEARING LEGAL NOTICE TO AMEND THE OTTAWA COUNTY
REGULATIONS TO INCREASE NON-RESIDENTIAL BUILDING PERMIT AND
OTHER ASSOCIATED FEES

Notice is hereby given that public hearings will be held before the Board of Ottawa County Commissioners on March 29, 2018 at 5:30 p.m. in the Emergency Management Operations EOC in the basement of the courthouse, 315 Madison Street, Port Clinton (must use Sheriff's Office entrance for access) and April 5, 2018 at 11:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Assembly Room on the first floor of the courthouse. The hearings are for the purpose of considering the adoption of a revised fee schedule to coincide with the Ohio Board of Building Standards new codes for commercial, industrial, and multi-family dwellings. The regulations are authorized under Section 307.37 and 3781.102 of the Ohio Revised Code.

The proposed fee schedule will be available for public inspection at the Board of Building Standards office room 104, during the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, except holidays.

At the conclusion of all hearings, the matter will be decided by the Board of Ottawa County Commissioners.
