The Ottawa County Dog Warden is currently seeking a **full-time DEPUTY DOG WARDEN**, responsible for assisting the Chief Dog Warden in performing the day-to-day operations of the department and of the Dog Shelter.

Qualified candidates **must**:

- Have a High School diploma or equivalent
- Have a valid Ohio driver's license and an acceptable driving record
- Be available to work overtime with little or no notice for call-outs
- Be available for after-hours call-outs
- Have working telephone to be reached
- Be physically and mentally able to perform duties, including:
 - working with large and/or aggressive dogs,
 - working in adverse conditions,
 - cleaning kennels,
 - feeding, bathing and walking dogs,
 - conducting investigations of complaints
 - issuing citations for violations
 - dealing with difficult people and/or dog owners
- Be able to work with the public in a professional manner
- Be able to work independently or as part of the team
- Be available to work (generally) 10am to 6pm, Monday through Friday and one Saturday per month, as well as on-call every other weekend (including 2 shelters visits each weekend day)
- Live locally in order to meet the 30-minute call-out response requirement
- Be able to lift up to 100 lbs while twisting or turning
- **Other Preferred Qualifications include:**
 - **Vocational/technical training in animal behavior or related field**
 - **Interest or training in some kind of law enforcement environment**
 - **Six (6) months' experience in the field, or any equivalent combination of education and experience that provides the necessary knowledge, skills, and abilities**



The position works approximately 40 hours per week with access to **all County benefits** including medical, dental, vision & life insurance; paid sick & vacation leave; paid holidays and more!
