Ottawa County, a largely rural county on the shores of Lake Erie, is currently seeking applicants for the position of Social Service Worker 2 in the Child and Adult Protective Services division. This position is part of a team of community members working to ensure children are safe and well cared for. The team member receives allegations of child abuse or neglect, investigates as directed, and helps families to connect to the services needed to provide a home environment where children can thrive.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Bachelor's degree in human service related field; OR Bachelor's degree in any field and 2 years of experience in human service occupation; OR Associate degree in human service related field; OR Five years of experience in human service related work. NOTE: a bachelor's degree in human service related field is required within five years of hire date.

PAY RANGE: \$15.44 to \$19.20 per hour, based on qualifications, with additional pay supplements when complete job related bachelor's degree, CORE child welfare training curriculum and initial probationary period.
