

INVITATION TO BID

SEALED BIDS for the furnishing of the necessary materials and rehabilitation of the

MOORE'S DOCK ROAD SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION / REPLACEMENT PROJECT

will be received by Ottawa County, Ohio at the office of the Board of Ottawa County Commissioners, 315 Madison Street, Room 103, Port Clinton, Ohio 43452 until

11:30 a.m. (Local Time)
September 3, 2020

and at that time and place will be publicly opened and read aloud.

In general, the work consists of removing manhole coatings and cure-in-place restoration of manholes; cure-in-place restoration of truss pipe sanitary sewers and laterals, and the installation of vac-a-tee cleanouts. All work is within the public right-of-way or an easement.

A pre-bid conference will be held 1:00 p.m. local time on August 20, 2020 at the Catawba Island Club Condos, Moore's Dock Road, Port Clinton, Ohio 43452. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is highly encouraged but is not mandatory.

Neither Owner nor Engineer has any responsibility for the accuracy, completeness or sufficiency of any bid documents obtained from any source other than the source indicated in these documents. Obtaining these documents from any other source(s) may result in obtaining incomplete and inaccurate information. Obtaining these documents from any source other than directly from the source listed herein may also result in failure to receive any addenda, corrections, or other revisions to these documents that may be issued.

Bids must be signed and submitted on the forms bound herein, must contain the names of every person or company interested therein. Bids must state the unit prices in the blanks provided and be enclosed in a sealed envelope marked --- **Moore's Dock Road Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation / Replacement Project** --- and addressed to the Board of Commissioners, Ottawa County, 315 Madison Street, Port Clinton, Ohio 43452.

Bid shall be accompanied by either a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in the amount of 100% of the amount bid with satisfactory corporate surety, or by a certified check on a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the amount of the Bid, subject to conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders. The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance Bond and Maintenance and

Guarantee Bond in the amount of 100% of the Bid. The bid guarantee must meet the requirements of Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code.

After the award of the contract let by competitive bid and prior to the time the contract is entered into, bidders shall submit the affidavit required under the Ohio Revised Code, Section 5719.042 that the bidder was not charged with any delinquent personal property taxes in Ottawa County, Ohio.

The Contractor shall be required to pay not less than the prevailing wage rates established by the Ohio Department of Commerce, Bureau of Wage and Hour Administration, 614-644-2239. Any Bid may be withdrawn prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of Bids, but no bidder shall withdraw his Bid within 60 days after the actual opening thereof.

Domestic steel use requirements as specified in Section 153.011 of the Revised Code apply to this project. Copies of Section 153.011 of the Revised Code can be obtained from any of the offices of the Department of Administrative Services.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept any Bid which is deemed most favorable to the Owner. Bidders with Unresolved Findings for Recovery on the State Auditor's web site will be disqualified.

Each bidder shall complete a "Non-Collusion" Affidavit and include it with his proposal. Bids received after the scheduled bid opening date and time, or not accompanied by a satisfactory bid bond or check, will neither be read or considered. All contractors and subcontractors with the project will to the extent practicable use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123 is required.

In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 307.87, this shall serve as notification that this invitation is available on Ottawa County's internet web site on the world wide web by logging onto www.co.ottawa.oh.us and going to the legal notices/bids link. The project is being partially funded with monies from the Ohio Public Works Commission.

The owner intends and requires that this project be started no earlier than November 2, 2020 and completed no later than May 14, 2021.

Engineer's estimate for the project is \$286,150.00.
